- 01 The development hereby permitted must be begun within a period of five years beginning with the date on which this permission is granted.

- 02 The stables shall be used only to accommodate the applicant's own horses and shall not be used for any commercial riding, breeding or training purposes.  
(Reason: To avoid the establishment of an inappropriate use)
- 03 Details of all external facing and roofing materials shall be submitted to, and approved by, the Local Planning Authority in writing before development commences.  
(Reason: To ensure a satisfactory external appearance.)
